Old Business:

Motion was given by Thom Dolder to increase monthly amounts sent to our Kitsap Bank Water Operations & Maintenance account (522) and Water Capital Improvements account (523) from \$500 per month to \$750 per month, seconded by Loren Chilson...voted on and approved 4-0.

Discussion of Enforcement of Water Bill item from Nov 2013 meeting... Loren and Phil indicated that it has been the policy of the board since 2008 that water usage through a customers meter is the sole responsibility of the customer. Phil mentioned that we had received guidance from our loan guarantor (USDA) in 2008 that mentioned no forgiveness. Loren will

send the language from the November 2013 minutes to USDA for comment.

New Business:

There will be no new fish deliveries for this opening day of fishing as all fish were delivered after close of fishing last fall.

Report on Well #1 concrete tank replacement (11,500 gallons). Washington State Dept of Health, Office of Drinking Water had identified in 2013 during our system-wide inspection that this concrete tank is in need of repair or replacement. Loren has checked with Nicholson Drilling who have indicated that the repair of the tank from inside would not hold so are recommending replacement of tank with a heavy gauge plastic fiber tank (10,000 gallons). Loren will research alternate sources for repair or replacement of this tank.

Insurance Coverage change...Thom Dolder has volunteered to find a replacement insurer for our comprehensive insurance policy with Propel Insurance which expires on 1 March 2014. Motion was given by Loren Chilson to allow Thom Dolder to research replacement insurance for the community, seconded by Phil Freund...voted on and approved 4-0.

Trees downed by Mason County Sherriff Office and Dept of Natural Resources to block access of thieves on dirt bikes through ravine at end of Raintree Lane. Candace Gadley had asked a member of the community to remove all the downed trees. The board will further study what can be done to block access to the ravine. Tabled for further study.
